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Learning at Linden

Food Technology

Not sure what to do who your left over pumpkins? Why not try this delicious recipe from our Food Technology department?





Pumpkin cake

Ingredients

300g self-raising flour

300g light soft brown sugar

- 3 teaspoons mixed spice
- 2 teaspoon bicarbonate of soda
- 175g raisins
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 4 eggs

200g dairy free spread

1 orange

1 tablespoon orange juice

500g pumpkin puree

For frosting

200g soft cheese 85g dairy free spread 100g icing sugar 1 orange (zest and juice of half)



Instructions

preheat oven to 160C, Weigh and measure all ingredients, Crack the eggs, Zest and juice oranges, Melt the 200g spread.

- Put the flour, sugar, spice, bicarbonate of soda, sultanas and salt into a large bowl and stir to combine.
- Beat the eggs into the melted butter, stir in the orange zest and juice.
- 3. Tip in and mix with the dry ingredients till combined.
- 4. Add and stir in the pumpkin.
- Pour the batter into a 25x30cm tin and bake for 30 minutes, or until golden and springy to the touch.
- 6. Until cake is baking make the frosting.
- Tip soft cheese, butter, icing sugar, orange zest and 1 tsp of the juice into a clean mixing bowl and beat using an electric mixer until smooth and creamy.



8. Set aside in the fridge. When the cake is done, cool for 5 mins then turn it onto a cooling rack. Prick it all over with a skewer and drizzle with the rest of the orange juice while still warm. Leave to cool completely. Give the frosting a quick beat to loosen, then, using a palette knife, spread over the top of the cake in peaks and swirls

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
