Early Years Foundation Stage + (2 – 5 years) The EYFS+ curriculum is designed for pupils with a vision and multi-sensory impairment. It incorporates the EYFS curriculum as well as the specialist curriculum for example the Curriculum Framework for Vision Impairment (CFVI) Within the EYFS+ curriculum, we use the seven areas of learning to deliver a broad and balanced educational offer.

Prime areas: Communication and language/ Physical development, Physical development/ Personal, social and emotional development

Specific areas: Literacy/ mathematics/ Understanding the world/ Expressive arts and design

Alba+

The Alba+ curriculum is for our pupils who are multi-sensory impaired (deaf/blind). The curriculum is divided into eight domains of learning:

1. Communication
2. Social and emotional development
3. Conceptual development
4. Sensory resources
5. Understanding time and place
6. Orientation, movement and mobility
7. Ownership of learning
8. Responses to routines and changes
