Christmas at Woodlarks

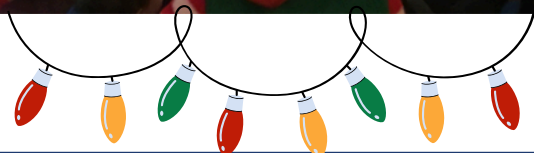
Ukulele and Violin Class went to Woodlarks yesterday.

Oliver and James for enjoying a beautiful moment as friends before a transition to the next activity.

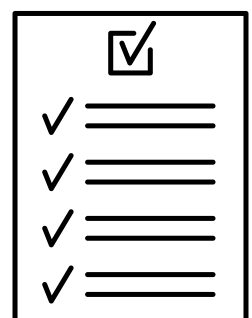


Photo Consent Form 2024-25
