Learning at Linden

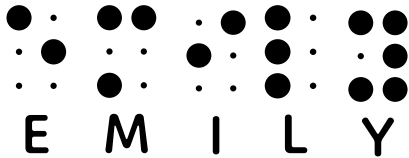
Braille 200

To celebrate 200 years of braille a braille learner will share their braille journey each week. Everyone has a different and unique lesson tailored to their own personalised learning goal each week.

This week Emily is sharing her Braille learning journey:

I have really enjoyed learning Braille over the last few years. I have found it interesting that braille is a combination of six dots. I have a braille session once a week with Leonie and do reading and braille. It is fun.

Emily uses Grade 2 contracted braille which involves making words shorter using contractions, word signs and shortforms.
