Tadas for amazing eating. Tadas ate two portions of lasagna and some cake on Thursday!

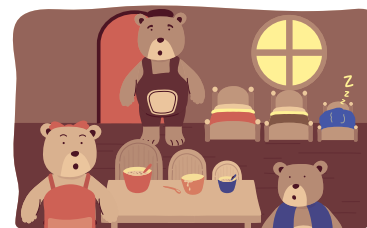


Learning at Linden - Early Years
