James for brilliant use of his iPad as always, and, in particular this week, for asking for more when playing games with his friends in class.

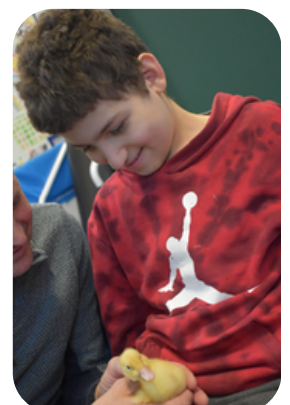
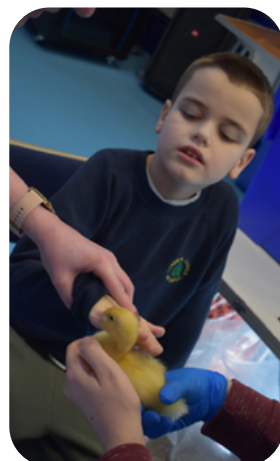
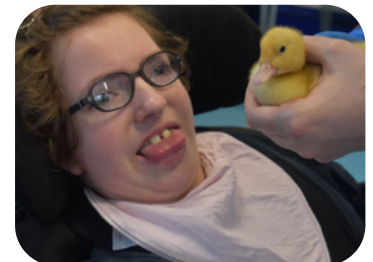
