

# What Happens in Playgroup sessions?

Playgroups are returning in the new year. Look out for the schedule in the coming weeks and book your space.



All of our playgroups last for 2 hours and are appropriate for children aged 18 months - 3 years. These groups are developed by our highly skilled teachers to provide for the overall development of young children with a sensory loss.

Parents attend these sessions alongside their child and engage in activities which promote learning throughout all our daily activities.

A typical session includes:

- A 'welcome' session
- A snack time
- Story time
- Sensory play
- Creative play
- Music and songs
- Outside play weather permitting
- A 'farewell session
