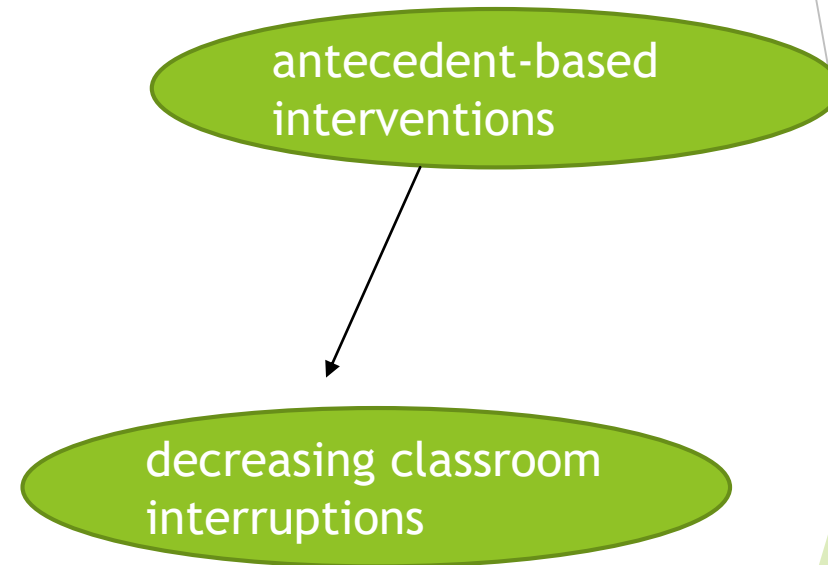
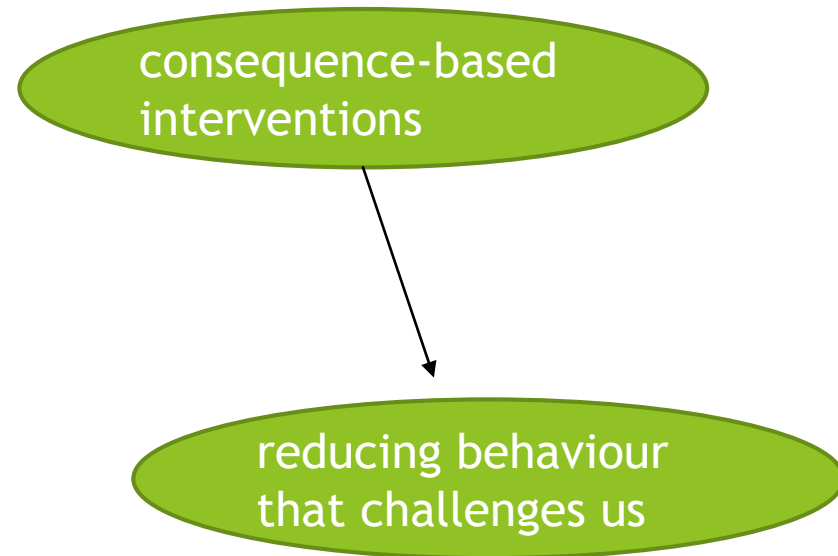

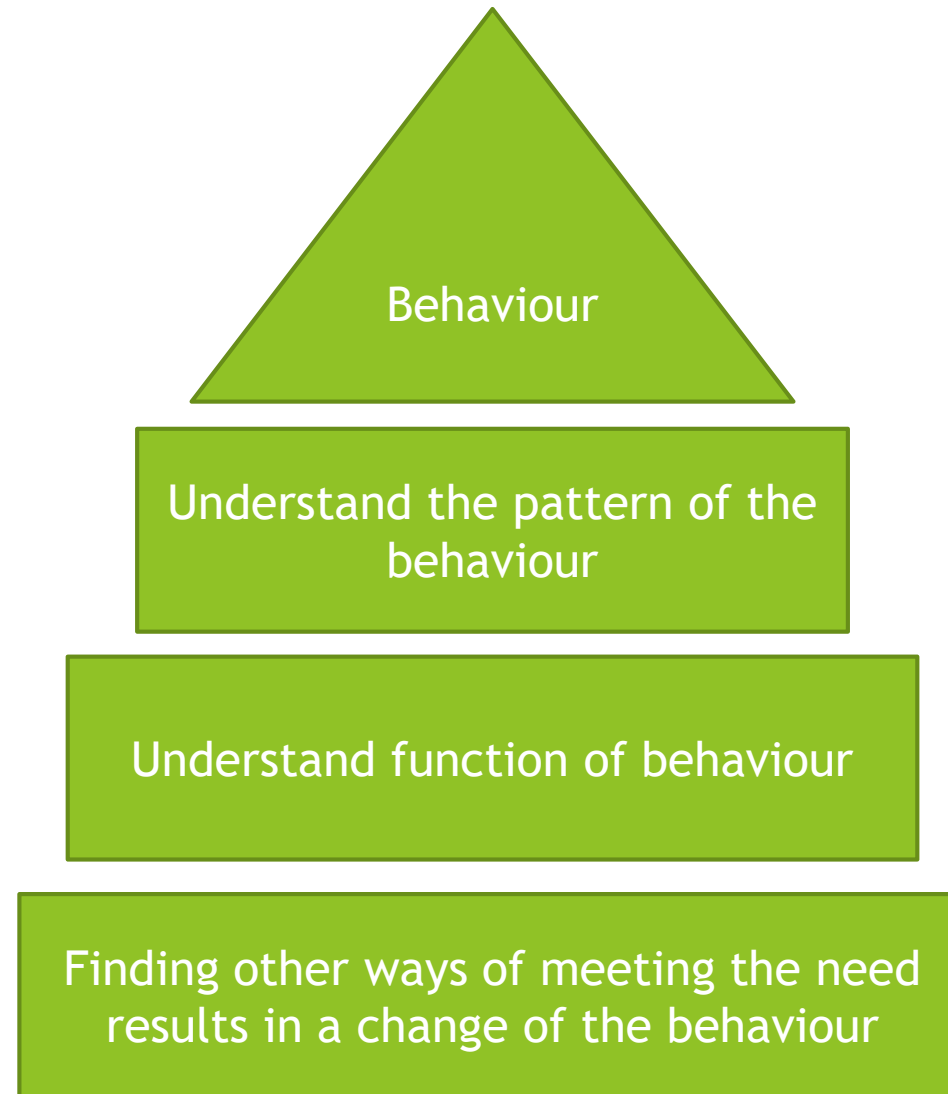

Positive Behaviour Support (PBS)

PBS is: “Reinforcing the good things and praising the achievements”

PBS is: “Focusing on the behaviour of the student and what you want them to do, rather than what you don't want them to do”



Reasons to use visuals

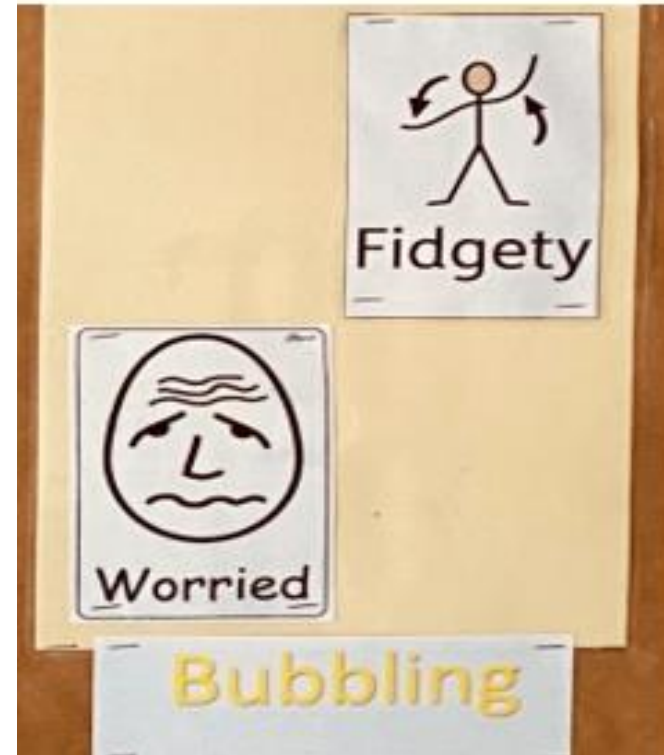

- VISUALS HELP REDUCE ANXIETY

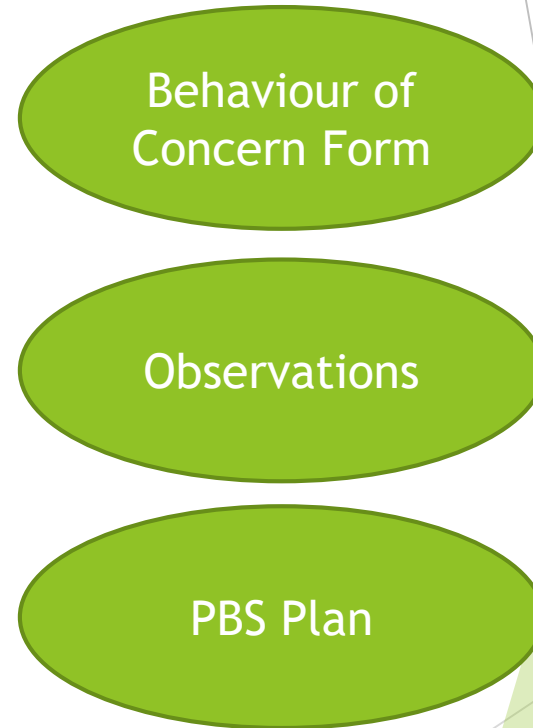
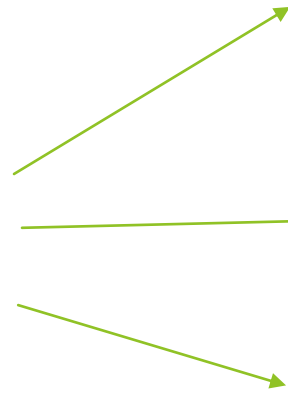
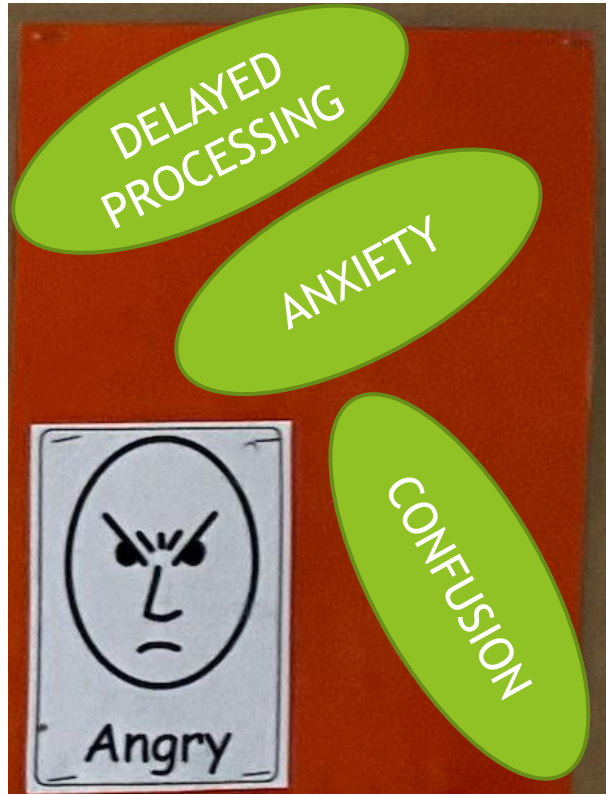
Zones of regulation



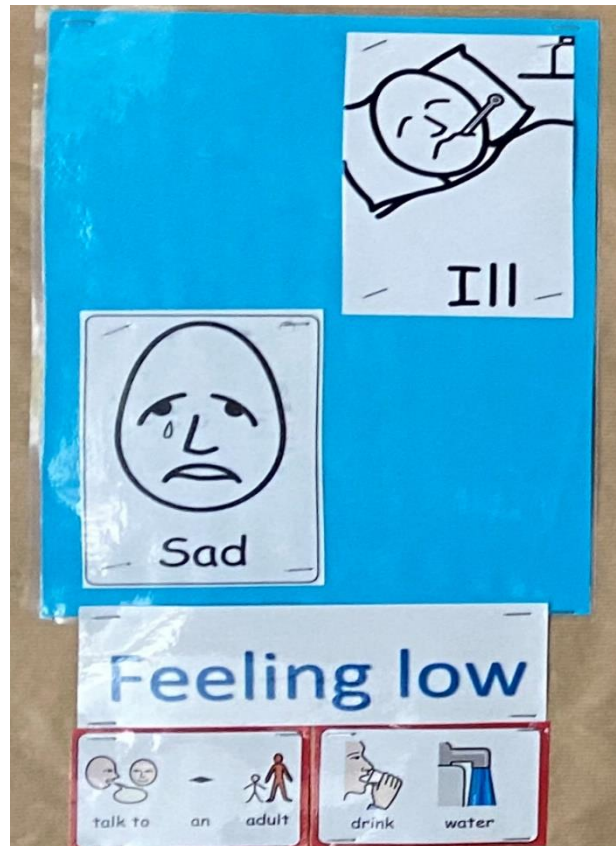
Green & orange zones
